Paul Tournier Prize 2026

The International College of Person Centered Medicine (ICPCM) has established the *Paul Tournier Prize* in order to promote Person Centered Medicine by honoring Paul Tournier's legacy, in cooperation with the Paul Tournier Association and the Paul Tournier family.

The Prize involves the presentation of the Paul Tournier Lecture 2026 to be delivered on 1-2 April 2026 within the framework of the 18h Geneva Conference on Person Centered Medicine by the awardee who will receive a plaque celebrating the Prize. It also involves the publication of the Lecture in academic format in the *International Journal of Person Centered Medicine* (IJPCM).

The winner of the Paul Tournier Prize will be selected by a jury composed of three representatives of the ICPCM Board (one being the ICPCM President who will chair the jury) and two representatives of the Paul Tournier Association.

The general criteria for the selection of the Paul Tournier Prize winner are the following: a) High international stature in the field of Person Centered Medicine, broadly considered, b) Publication record involving important books or papers in the field of Person Centered Medicine, broadly considered, c) Ability and willingness to deliver an inspiring Prize lecture in the course of a 18th Geneva Conference on PCM on 1-2 April 2026 and publication of a related manuscript in the *International Journal of Person Centered Medicine*, and d) Not being a member of the Boards of the ICPCM or the Paul Tournier Association.
